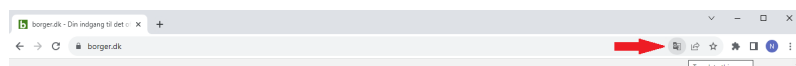
Log in

1. Go to the self-service page at <https://lifeindenmark.borger.dk/working/holiday-allowance-ny/holiday-allowance>
2. Click 'Start'

4. Log in with MitID



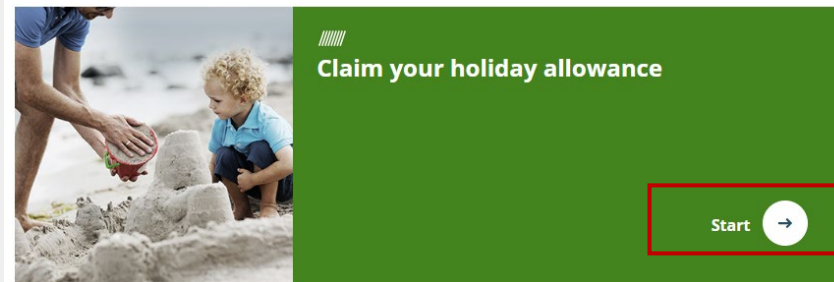
